ARRANGEMENT OF THE TABERNACLE FURNISHINGS


"Now of the things which we have spoken serve unto the example and SHADOW of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle."

Hebrews 8:1, 5













GOD DESIRES TO DWELL WITH HIS PEOPLE.


GOD DESIRES TO TABERNACLE (DWELL WITH) HIS PEOPLE




"Make me [God] a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them" (Exodus 25:8).


