- A "cubit" was the measurement from a man's elbow to the tip of his middle finger (equal to 18 inches).
- "Twined linen" was a superior quality made from yarn of which each thread was composed of MANY delicate strands.
- Before we approach God (the Holy of Holies), we must pass the curtains.
- "Pillars" are not just a few saints.
- The four pillars of the gate represent the four Gospel writers (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John) who wrote about the work of Christ so others could "enter."

"BLUE"— Jesus is Divine


- "PURPLE"— Jesus must be Lord of your life
- "Scarlet"— Jesus' death on the Cross "Fine, Twined Linen" — White


