

To Get to the Altar

- Curtains (RIGHTEOUSNESS & UNITY of God's people) pointed the way.
- Must come past the curtain of the gate.
 - Jesus is Lord, King & Savior

The Brazen Altar

- 7½ feet square x 4½ feet tall
- Largest piece of furniture
- Made of wood (humanity) covered with copper (God's judgments)

Leviticus 1:2 – "If any man of you bring an offering unto the LORD, ye shall bring your offering of the cattle, even of the herd, and of the flock."



- "IF" it was voluntary
 - Joshua 24:15 "Choose you ... whom ye will serve."
- "OFFERING" the Hebrew word means "to draw near"
 - James 4:8 "Draw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you."
- "CATTLE" livestock
- "HERD" oxen, bullock
- "FLOCK" sheep or goats
- "BRING" to the altar

- "BURNT SACRIFICE" the entire sacrifice was burned
- "WITHOUT BLEMISH" without disease or blemish of any kind
 - A defective sacrifice was an insult and a deception (Malachi 1:14).

- Spotless & Complete Sacrifice
 - Christ and the church
 - 1 Peter 1:19; Eph. 5:27; Rom. 12:1; 1 Thess. 5:23

Leviticus 1:3 - "If his offering be a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish."



Leviticus 1:4 – "And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him."



• "PUT HIS HAND UPON THE HEAD"

- admitting his guilt
- acknowledging sin's penalty is death
- admitting the animal was making ATONEMENT for him
 - ATONEMENT = "a covering "

SPIRITUAL LESSON

- "The LORD hath laid on him [Jesus] the iniquity [sins] of us all" (Isaiah 53:6).
- Atonement = a covering for our sins

- "HE SHALL KILL" the man who sinned killed the lamb
 - God designed this to create a HATRED for sin.

- Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death."
- How do we view sin?
- How does God view sin?
- Sin is SERIOUS and CONSEQUENCES are painful!


Leviticus 1:5 – "And he shall kill the bullock before the LORD."




- QUESTION What is so important about the blood?
 - Leviticus 17:11 "For the life of the flesh is in the blood."

- Physical blood represents the life of people & animals.
- New life (born again) requires blood (Calvary).
 - Hebrews 9:22 "Without shedding of blood is no remission [forgiveness]."

Leviticus 1:5 – "And the priests, Aaron's sons, shall bring the blood, and sprinkle the blood round about upon the altar."





Tetelestai – It Is Finished!

Leviticus 8:15 - "And Moses took the blood, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about with his finger."



"THE HORNS"

- four horns, said to be facing outwards
- pointing to the four corners of the earth
 - Salvation is for ALL

"UPON THE HORNS"

• horns represent power Psalm 87:17; 18:2; Luke 1:69

SPIRITUAL LESSON

- "There's still power in the blood of Jesus."
- "What can wash away my sins? Nothing but the blood of Jesus."

- Romans 3:25 AMP
 - "God displayed [Jesus]
 publicly [on the Cross] as a
 life-giving sacrifice."
 - Jesus was "a PROPITIATION"
 - a reconciliation with God
 - same word translated as "MERCY SEAT"
 - "through faith in his blood"

- "faith in his blood" = obedience to His Word
- Your faith will affect others.
- There is no safety when you leave "the house."
