- The cherubims were to show the WAY back into God's presence.

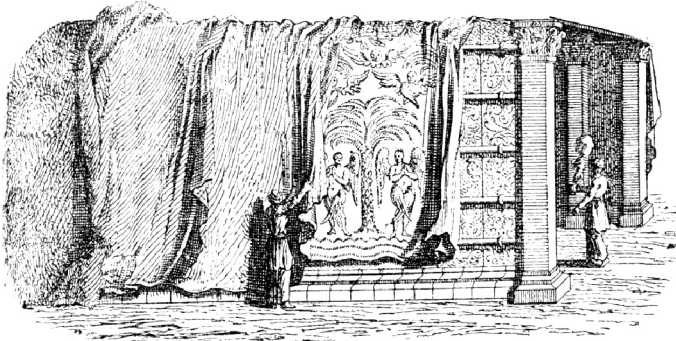


## VOCABULARY WORDS & TERMS

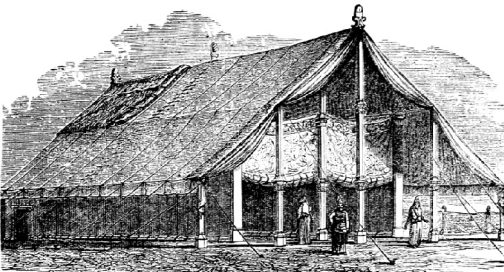
