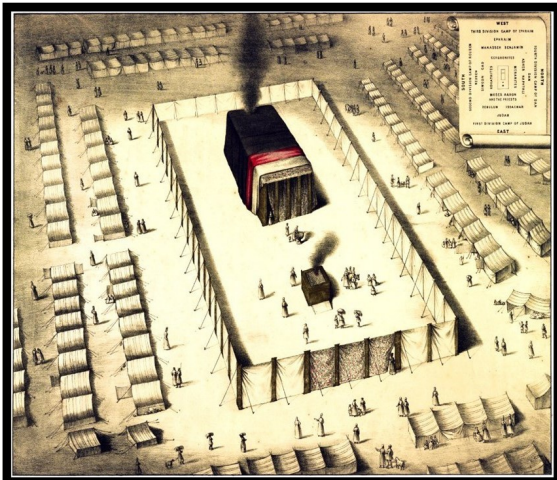

**DID YOU KNOW?**

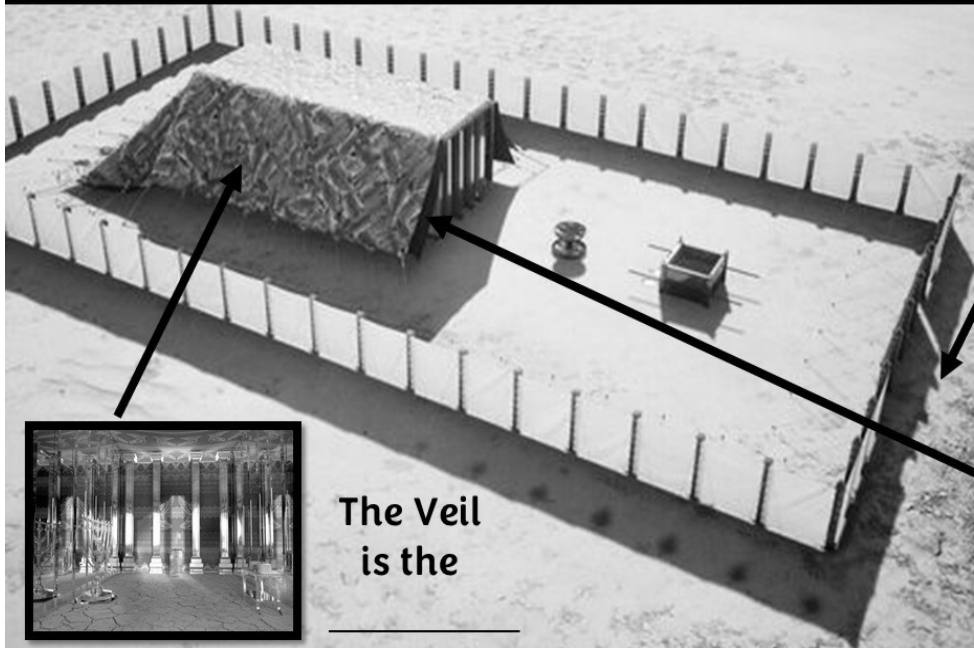
- The veil separated "the holy place" from "the most holy" place.
- Only the high priest could access the second room, once a year, on the Day of Atonement.
- The veil was woven of 72 threads, and every thread had 24 threads in it.
- The veil covered the Ark of the Testimony when it was being moved.
- Cherubims embroidered on the veil show Christ cannot be separated from His body (the church).

DISTINCTIVE**

- **The Tabernacle (God's dwelling place in the Old Testament) stood out.**
- **As Christians (God's dwelling place today), how will we reach people if we blend in?**
- **We are to be "a city ... set on a hill [that] cannot be hid" (Matthew 5:14).**

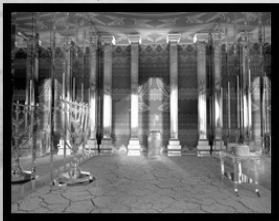

## WHAT DOES THE DESCRIPTION OF THE VEIL SYMBOLIZE?

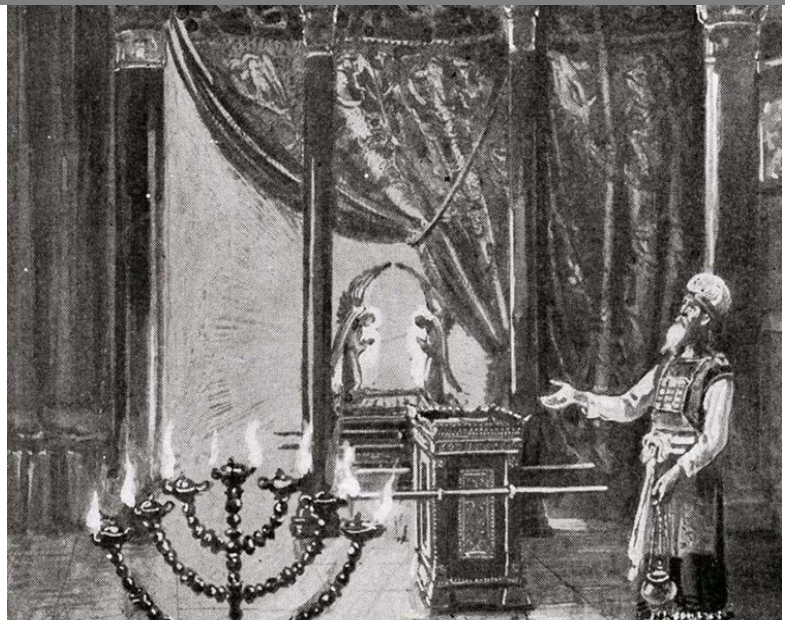
\_\_\_\_\_ **Jesus is the Son of God; to be "born again" is to be "born from above."**
