

D. S. Warner and the saints would go into a town with a buckboard wagon. They would travel in caravans, and all the singers, the instrument players, and the preacher would ride in the same wagon. When they reached the edge of town, someone would start singing. They would sing all the way through town, and people would ask, "Who are these people?" By the time they got to the end of town, they had many people following them. Then, one of the brethren would take a Bible, stand up on the old buckboard, and start preaching.
